## A Bill to Promote American-made Goods [Buy America]

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** American-made goods will be promoted through an increase on import  
3 tariffs.

4 **SECTION 2.** American-made goods will be defined as products that at least 50% of the  
5 production cost (labor, materials, overhead) is incurred in the United  
6 States and the final assembly or transformation takes place in the U.S.  
7 Promoted will refer to as being supported or more actively encouraged.

8 **SECTION 3.** In order to promote American made goods, foreign import tariffs will be  
9 raised to a 10% minimum and adjusted per country as needed.

10 **SECTION 4.** This will be enforced by the US Foreign Relations Committee.

11 **SECTION 5.** This bill will be implemented 6 months after passage.

12 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

## A Bill to Stop Oil Drilling in Oceans

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The act of drilling for oil in any ocean will hereby become illegal.

3 **SECTION 2.** Ocean shall be defined as territorial waters of the United States.

4 **SECTION 3.** The E.P.A. will oversee these changes.

5 **A.** The E.P.A will fund the dismantling of existing oil rigs.

6 **SECTION 4.** These changes will go into effect 6 months after the bill's passage.

7 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# A Resolution to Ban the External Storage and Use of Nuclear Weapons

## **[Keep Nuclear Weapons Inside a Nations Borders]**

**WHEREAS,** This could lead and has lead to complications and heightened tension amongst countries that are neighbors to the nuclear storage country; and

**WHEREAS,** This could lead to one of the countries launching the missile and then blame it on the storage country and make it harder to detect nuclear weapons; and

**WHEREAS,** By passing this resolution it could lessen regional tension between nuclear backed countries; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED,** That the Congress here assembled propose a treaty to the United Nations with the intent of banning nuclear weapons outside of a country's sovereign territory worldwide.

# A Bill to End Discrimination in Applications [Equal Opportunity Scholarship Applications]

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.**       **A.** No federally funded scholarships will ask for or be based upon the factors of race, gender, or  
3 ethnicity; applicants shall in no way be discriminated against due to any of the aforementioned  
4 factors. Scholarships shall be based solely upon merit and achievement.

5 **B.** Employers of all job applicants, within the jurisdiction or boundaries of the United States of  
6 America, will no longer be allowed to ask for race, gender, or ethnicity; none of the said factors  
7 shall have any sway in the hiring process.

8 **SECTION 2.**       No students with a scholarship of aforementioned factors prior to passage of this bill shall have  
9 scholarships taken away upon passage of this legislation.

10 **SECTION 3.**       All those not in compliance with this bill will be fined a minimum of \$1,000 per application and a  
11 maximum of \$100,000 per application.

12 **SECTION 4.**       The enforcement of this legislation will be overseen by Equal Employment Opportunity  
13 Commission (EEOC).

14 **SECTION 5.**       This law will take effect within six months of passage.

15 **SECTION 6.**       All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.



# A Bill to Restructure the Organ Donation System

## [Organ Donation Enhancement]

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The age requirement restricting minors from enlisting themselves as  
3 organ and/or tissue donors will be abolished; thereby, extending the  
4 donation ages to include all individuals holding a driver's license in any  
5 territory of the United States, including the District of Colombia.

6 **SECTION 2.** Organs and Tissues will be defined as the parts of the body that can be  
7 safely and effectively removed and/or implanted as defined by the  
8 Department of Health and Human Services.

9 **SECTION 3.** A. The check box system of "Would you like to be an organ donor? Check  
10 Yes or No," will now be placed into default of being a donor, primarily  
11 meaning that those who leave this section blank are to be placed in the  
12 status of organ donor, and the form will accompany all driver's license  
13 applications.

14 B. In the case that the patient does not have an identification card, said  
15 patient will be assumed not a donor until requested otherwise of the  
16 next of kin.

17 **SECTION 4.** This will be overseen by the Department of Health and Human Services.

18 **SECTION 5.** This law will take effect within six months of passage.

19 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# A Bill to Abolish Class-Action Lawsuit Advertisement

## [Ban Class-Action Lawsuit Advertisement]

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** All public advertisement pertaining to any class-action lawsuit shall be  
3 henceforth terminated.

4 **SECTION 2.** Advertisement shall be defined as a paid announcement in newspapers  
5 or magazines, on radio or television, etc.

6 A class-action lawsuit shall be defined as any lawsuit where an entity  
7 sues a group of entities, a group of entities sues another group of  
8 entities, or a group of entities sues an entity.

9 Entity shall be defined as a person or corporation.

10 **SECTION 3.** Failure to comply will result in a minimum \$1,000 and a maximum  
11 \$500,000 fine for the company that produces the advertisement, and a  
12 \$1,000 fine per projected viewer for the broadcasting corporation.

13 **SECTION 4.** The FCC (Federal Communications Commission) shall oversee the  
14 enforcement of this bill.

15 **SECTION 5.** This law will take effect six months after passage.

16 **SECTION 6.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.

# A Resolution to Amend the Constitution to Abolish the Electoral College [Eliminate the Electoral College]

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **RESOLVED,** By two-thirds of the Congress here assembled, that the following article  
3 is proposed as an amendment to the Constitution of the United States,  
4 which shall be valid to all intents and purposes as part of the Constitution  
5 when ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several states  
6 within seven years from the date of its submission by the Congress:

7 **ARTICLE --**

8 **SECTION 1:** Regarding the 12<sup>th</sup> amendment; the Electoral College creates unequal  
9 voting power and it opens up the possibility of winning an election  
10 without having the popular vote. Additionally, more populated states  
11 have disproportional influence with the "winner-take-all" rule, thus  
12 discouraging campaigning in less populated states.

13 **SECTION 2:** The Congress shall have power to enforce this article by appropriate  
14 legislation.

# A Bill to Enact a Fair and Simple Tax [Impose a 13% Flat Tax]

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE CONGRESS HERE ASSEMBLED THAT:

2 **SECTION 1.** The fair tax be enacted to create a fair and simple tax plan that will  
3 stimulate economic recovery and expansion, spur capital investment,  
4 technology and research advancement, reduce the tax burden from labor  
5 to capital, and end the draconian effect of the present tax codes.

6 **SECTION 2.** The fair tax amends the internal revenue code to revise individual tax  
7 rates and imposes a tax rate of 13 percent on the taxable income of every  
8 individual, estate, and trust.

9 **SECTION 3.** The Internal Revenue Service (IRS) will see to the enforcement of this bill.

10 **SECTION 4.** The implementation of this bill will begin immediately upon passage.

11 **SECTION 5.** All laws in conflict with this legislation are hereby declared null and void.
